1975年3月に東京理科大学大学院理工学研究科物理学専攻修士課程を修了後、同年4月に石油資源開発（株）の物理探鉱部に入社。物理探査のデジタル処理技術の開発に従事。1982年12月から1985年4月まで、カナダのブリテッシュコロンビア大学に留学、1998年3月に京都大学工学研究科資源工学の助教授就任、2001年11月に教授に昇進、2015年3月に定年退職。京都大学名誉教授。4月から、公益財団法人深田地質研究所に勤務。現在インドネシアジャワ島での GundihCCS プロジェクトに従事中。

Dr. Toshifumi Matsuoka graduated with an MS in Physics from Tokyo University of Science in 1975 and joined Japan Petroleum Exploration Co., Ltd. (JAPEX) as a research geophysicist. He received Ph. D. from the University of Tokyo in 1995. 1983 to 1985, he was invited from the University of British Columbia, Canada, as a visiting researcher at the Department of Geophysics and Astronomy. Dr. Matsuoka worked as a geoscientist at JAPEX and JNOC (Japan National Oil Co). In 1998, he moved to Kyoto University and was promoted to the Professor of Geological Engineering Lab in 2002. Dr. Matsuoka organized the NanoGeoscience research group granted by JAPEX for the energy resources. In March 2015, he retired Kyoto University and moved to Fukada Geological Institute, Tokyo, Japan. Dr. Matsuoka is an Emeritus Professor at Kyoto University and Adjunct Professor, Institut Teknologi Bandung, Indonesia. He is a member of SEG, SPE, JAPT (Japanese Association for Petroleum Technology), and SEG Japan and others. He has been working the CCS project and serves committee members of the Japanese Government for the Tomakomai CCS project. Dr. Matsuoka was the Project Leader of “Gundih CCS project at Central Java, Indonesia.”
