Head of CCUS Business Development BP

Daniel Fletcher is bp's global Head of Carbon Capture Utilisation and Storage (CCUS) Business Development. In this role, he is responsible for developing bp's existing CCUS businesses and origination of new CCUS business across the globe, including CO2 shipping.

Daniel is passionate about developing energy and people and has worked in bp for over fifteen years in many different regions, across a variety of technical and commercial roles in the Upstream and Midstream sectors. Including most recently, leading development of bp's West Africa LNG business and as Chief of Staff for bp's new-region entry. He has previously managed bp's upstream exploration portfolio.

He is a regular guest lecturer at the University of Oxford Blavatnik School of Government's Executive Course on Oil Gas and Mining Governance.

Prior to joining BP, Daniel worked for Centrica in the power sector, where he worked in mergers & acquisitions on a number of investments, including the Hinkley Point C nuclear new build project. He has also worked as an analyst for investment bank Dresdner Kleinwort.

Daniel holds a First-Class Honours degree and Master of Science in Physics from Royal Holloway, University of London.
